

Remember, all HTML tags come in pairs, and yes, there are exceptions.

The basics: 1. All tags are enclosed by < >
 2. Ending tags of a pair has a / (slash)

Order of the tags: Define the page:

```
<html>
.....
</html>
```

The heading (used by the browser)

```
<head>
.....
</head>
```

The body - where all the good stuff goes

```
<body>
.....
</body>
```

The general html (web) page layout :

```
<html>
<head>
</head>
<body>
.....
</body>
</html>
```



All new tags
go here

Tags used inside the body (<body> </body>)

Headings: Largest <h1> ... </h1>
 <h2> ... </h2>
 <h3> ... </h3>
 <h4> ... </h4>
 <h5> ... </h5>
 <h6> ... </h6> smallest

Centering on web page

```
<div align="center">
.....
</div>
```

More tags

make text BOLD
 Italics <i> ... </i>

Tags that are NOT paired:

 	line break
<hr>	horizontal line
	bullet point

Put picture on web page:

```
<img src = " .... ">
```

show picture, name of picture inside the quotes

note: picture must be in same folder as html page

type this in or copy and paste from picture page

link to other pages

Link to another page: < a href = " ... ">

link to web page named inside the quote and highlight text in-between

link to another web site:

```
<a href = http://www.ccc.edu> City Colleges of Chicago</a>
```
